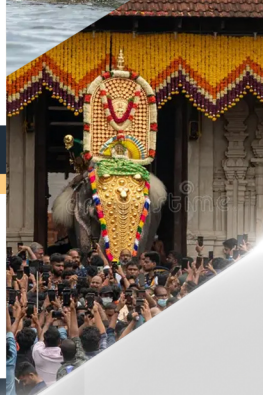

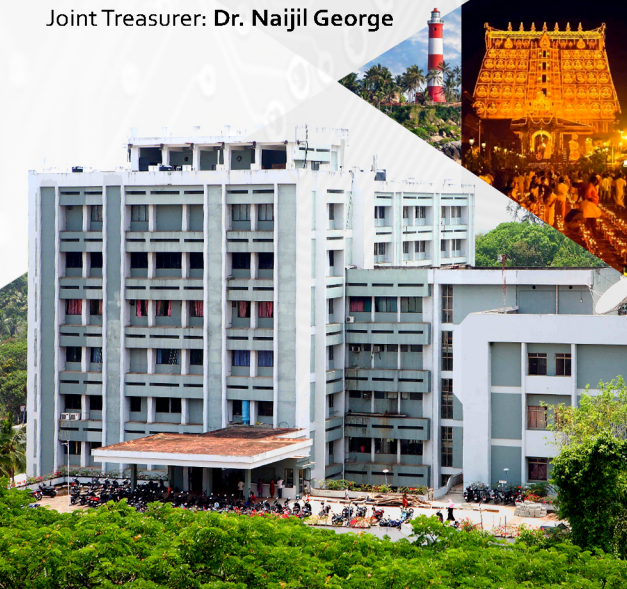

The Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram established in 1981, is an internationally recognised centre providing state-of-the-art facilities for cancer diagnosis, treatment, palliation and rehabilitation and conducting a wide range of research on various type of cancers. This state-owned premier cancer care hospital and research centre is one among the six centres instituted in India under the "National Cancer Control Programme" of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India. RCC is a Government of India-recognised "State Cancer Institute" and also holds the coveted NABH accreditation.



DIVISION OF CANCER RESEARCH, RCC THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Various laboratories in the Division of Cancer Research are carrying out active research in the fields of molecular and cellular aspects of tumor biology and related topics. The Division focuses on developing a better understanding of the molecular and cellular basis of disease, and to translate that understanding into practical outcomes for patients.

Main research works are going on in the areas of Cell Cycle Regulation & Molecular Oncology, Glycobiology & Phytopharmacology, Molecular Medicine, Cytogenetics & Molecular Diagnostics, Biopharmaceuticals & Nanomedicine, Immunopharmacology & Experimental Therapeutics and Cytogenetics. Research is also being carried out to identify potential drugs and vaccines for cancer, development of innovative cost effective technologies for patient care, and investigation on protective effects of natural products on the innate immune cells during radiation-induced injury. PCR, RT-PCR, and FISH based diagnostic methods have also been developed for patient care.

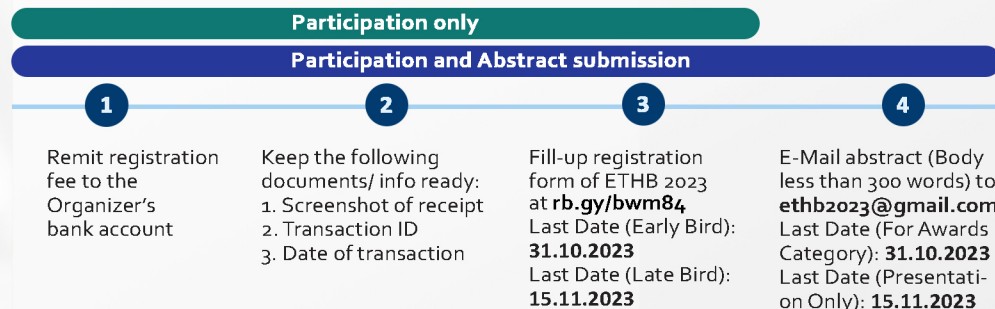
Abstract Specifications

1. The abstract must be submitted in doc./docx. formats.
2. The abstract must have:
 - (i) **Title** (Times New Roman; Bold, 14 pt; Centre aligned): Concise and informative.
 - (ii) **Author names and affiliations** (Times New Roman; Regular, 11 pt; Centre aligned): Indicate full names of each author and check that all names are accurately spelled. Present the authors' affiliation addresses (where the actual work was done) below the names. Indicate all affiliations with a lower-case superscript letter immediately after the author's name and in front of the appropriate address. Provide the full postal address of each affiliation. Clearly indicate presenting author (in Bold) and corresponding author using an asterisk (*) and/or hash (#) symbol. Provide E-mail ID of the corresponding author.
 - (iii) **Body** (Times New Roman; Regular, 11 pt; Left aligned; Justified): The body must be structured, and must state the Introduction, Aim of the study, Materials and Methods, Results, and Conclusions. Should not cross **300 words**.
 - (iv) **Keywords** (Times New Roman; Regular, 11 pt; Left aligned): The abstract should include three or four different keywords.

Submission of Abstract under SBTI Awards Category

Delegates can submit abstracts for consideration under six SBTI Awards Categories for young researchers (See page 5 for details). Delegates submitting abstracts under awards categories must indicate that in the registration form and clearly mention the award category under which the abstract is submitted in the E-Mail.
