

Dr. Anju T R, currently Secretary, Society for Biotechnologists (India) and Assistant Professor at Department of Biotechnology, Newman College, Kerala, India did her Bachelor's degree from Kerala University and Master's degree in Biotechnology from DBT funded Department at Gulbarga University, Karnataka.
